10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 10-1-104, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"10-1-104. Federal regulations to govern. (1) Federal laws and regulations, forms, precedents, and
14	usages relating to and governing the armed forces of the United States and the national guard, as in effect on
15	October 1, 2001 2003, insofar as they are applicable and not inconsistent with the constitution of this state, apply
16	to and govern the national guard of this state, including all members on active duty within the state as active duty
17	guard/reserve (AGR) personnel under Title 32 of the United States Code.
18	(2) The Uniform Code of Military Justice, as in effect on October 1, <del>2001</del> 2003, including the regulations,
19	manuals, forms, precedents, and usages implementing, interpreting, and complementing the code, is adopted
20	for use by the national guard of this state and applies, insofar as the code is not otherwise inconsistent with the
21	constitution of this state and except as otherwise provided by this title or by rule adopted by the department, to
22	the greatest extent practicable to govern the national guard of this state, including all members on active duty
23	within the state as active duty guard/reserve (AGR) personnel under Title 32 of the United States Code when
24	the members are serving other than in a federal capacity under Title 10 of the United States Code."
