16	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Placement of warning sign in water legally accessible to public
17	liability limitation ROLE OF DEPARTMENT. (1) A person or UNLESS ACTING WITH GROSS NEGLIGENCE, AN
18	INDIVIDUAL OR A nonprofit organization is not liable for civil damages resulting from the person's INDIVIDUAL'S of
19	organization's placement of a sign or marker warning of a hazard in water legally accessible to the public- AS
20	LONG AS:
21	(A) THE SIGN OR MARKER IS A WHITE PLASTIC MILK BOTTLE ATTACHED BY A CORD TO THE HAZARD OR IS A SIGN
22	OR MARKER APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT;
23	(B) THE SIGN OR MARKER CONTAINS OR BEARS THE NAME AND TELEPHONE NUMBER OF THE INDIVIDUAL OF
24	NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION THAT PLACED IT;
25	(C) THE INDIVIDUAL OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION MAINTAINS OR REMOVES THE SIGN OR MARKER WHEN
26	DICTATED BY CHANGING WATER CONDITIONS OR SEASONAL CHANGES; AND
27	(D) THE INDIVIDUAL OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATION PLACES THE SIGN OR MARKER ONLY FOR THE PURPOSE OF
28	IDENTIFYING HAZARDS.
29	(2) Section 87-1-303 does not prohibit, and may not be construed to prohibit or to allow the adoption
30	of rules prohibiting, a person or organization from placing a sign warning of a hazard in water legally accessible

2	(A) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION ARE NOT INTENDED TO PROHIBIT THE PLACEMENT OF NONHAZARD SIGNS
3	OR MARKERS FOR WATER SKIING, DIVING, SAFE CHANNELS, OR SWIMMING AREAS OR FOR POSTING SPEED LIMITS.
4	(B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL INFORM MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC INVOLVED IN THE RECREATIONAL USE OF THE
5	WATERS OF THIS STATE OF THE PLACEMENT, USE, AND SIGNIFICANCE OF SIGNS OR MARKERS WARNING OF HAZARDS IN
6	THE WATER THAT ARE PLACED BY INDIVIDUALS OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF THIS
7	SECTION.
8	(3) THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION APPLY ONLY TO THE WATERS OF THIS STATE THAT HAVE NOT BEEN
9	DETERMINED TO BE NAVIGABLE FOR PURPOSES OF FEDERAL JURISDICTION OVER NAVIGATION AIDS.

11	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
12	INTEGRAL PART OF TITLE 87, CHAPTER 1, PART 2, AND THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 87, CHAPTER 1, PART 2, APPLY TO
13	[SECTION 1].
