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13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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15	Section 1. Section 85-2-516, MCA, is amended to read:
16	"85-2-516. Well logs. (1) Within 60 days after any well is completed, the driller shall file with the
17	department <u>bureau</u> a well log report <u>.</u>
18	(2) Except as provided in subsection (3), the well log report must be filed on a form provided specified
19	by the department through its offices in consultation with the board of water well contractors provided for in
20	2-15-3307 and the bureau.
21	(3) The bureau may allow submission of the well log report in an electronic format that is in accordance
22	with the form specified as provided in subsection (2).
23	(4) The department bureau may return the report for refiling if it is incomplete or incorrect. The
24	department shall provide a copy of the complete and correct well log to the Montana bureau of mines and
25	geology. "
