8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 87-4-201, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"87-4-201. Taxidermist's license, fee, and penalty Regulation of taxidermists. A (1) As used in this
12	section, "taxidermist" means a person who engages in conducting any taxidermy business, as the term is
13	generally understood, or any person who conducts a business for the purpose of mounting, preserving, or
14	preparing <del>any</del> <u>all or part</u> of the dead bodies of any wildlife <del>or any part thereof</del> .
15	(2) Before conducting the business of a taxidermist, a taxidermist shall must first obtain from the director
16	department a taxidermist's license and pay an annual license fee of \$15 therefor \$75 \$50.
17	(3) Such person A taxidermist shall keep a written record of all the articles of wildlife in his the
18	taxidermist's possession or control, including the following information:
19	(a) the kind and number of each, article of wildlife;
20	(b) by whom owned, and the the name and residence of the owner, of the article of wildlife; and
21	(c) all the articles of wildlife shipped and to whom and where shipped.
22	(4) The above taxidermist shall keep the written record shall be kept required under subsection (3) for
23	as long as <del>such</del> the articles of wildlife remain in the possession of the licensee taxidermist but in any event or
24	at least 5 years, whichever is longer. These records shall must be open to inspection by any state game a
25	warden at any reasonable time.
26	(5) In all cases of Upon conviction of for a violation of this section, the taxidermist's license of the person
27	convicted may be revoked by the court."
