10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Bill introduction restrictions. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2),
11	a legislator may not introduce more than 10 bills in a legislative session.
12	(2) Subsection (1) does not apply to bills that are designated as introduced at the request of a state
13	governmental entity.

15	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
16	integral part of Title 5, chapter 4, part 1, and the provisions of Title 5, chapter 4, part 1, apply to [section 1].
