10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	
12	Section 1. Section 53-1-413, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"53-1-413. Deposit of payments and collections. (1) Except as provided in 90-7-220, 90-7-221, and
14	this section, the department shall deposit payments and collections of charges for a resident's cost of care in
15	the state treasury to the credit of the general fund.
16	(2) Payments and collections for services provided to residents of the Montana veterans' home must
17	be deposited in the special revenue account for the benefit of the home. Payments and collections for services
18	provided to residents of the Montana chemical dependency treatment center must be deposited in the state
19	special revenue account for the facility.
20	(3) Subject to 90-7-221, payments from a managed care organization that is contracting with the
21	department to administer a mental health managed care program for services provided by the Montana state
22	hospital and the Montana mental health nursing care center must be deposited in the state special revenue
23	account, subject to appropriation by the legislature for the benefit of those institutions.
24	(4) Medicaid payments for services provided by the Montana state hospital and the Montana menta
25	health nursing care center must be deposited in the federal special revenue fund and are subject to appropriation
26	for the benefit of the mental health managed care program."

28	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval JULY 1
