| 14 | Section 1. Section 2-2-102, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 15 | "2-2-102. Definitions. As used in this part, the following definitions apply: |
| 16 | (1) "Business" includes a corporation, partnership, sole proprietorship, trust or foundation, or any other |
| 17 | individual or organization carrying on a business, whether or not operated for profit. |
| 18 | (2) "Compensation" means any money or economic benefit conferred on or received by any person in |
| 19 | return for services rendered or to be rendered by the person or another. |
| 20 | (3) (a) "Gift of substantial value" means a gift with a value of 50 100 or more for an individual. |
| 21 | (b) The term does not include: |
| 22 | (i) a gift that is not used and that, within 30 days after receipt, is returned to the donor or delivered to |
| 23 | a charitable organization or the state and that is not claimed as a charitable contribution for federal income tax |
| 24 | purposes; |
| 25 | (ii) food and beverages consumed on the occasion when participation in a charitable, civic, or community |
| 26 | event bears a relationship to the public officer's or public employee's office or employment or when the officer |
| 27 | or employee is in attendance in an official capacity; |
| 28 | (iii) educational material directly related to official governmental duties; |
| 29 | (iv) an award or gift publicly presented in recognition of public service , including a gift given as a |
| 30 | traditional or cultural practice or at a traditional or cultural event or ceremony; or |
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| 1 | (v) educational activity that: |
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| 2 | (A) does not place or appear to place the recipient under obligation; |
| 3 | (B) clearly serves the public good; and |
| 4 | (C) is not lavish or extravagant. |
| 5 | (4) "Local government" means a county, a consolidated government, an incorporated city or town, a |
| 6 | school district, or a special district. |
| 7 | (5) "Official act" or "official action" means a vote, decision, recommendation, approval, disapproval, or |
| 8 | other action, including inaction, that involves the use of discretionary authority. |
| 9 | (6) "Private interest" means an interest held by an individual that is: |
| 10 | (a) an ownership interest in a business; |
| 11 | (b) a creditor interest in an insolvent business; |
| 12 | (c) an employment or prospective employment for which negotiations have begun; |
| 13 | (d) an ownership interest in real property; |
| 14 | (e) a loan or other debtor interest; or |
| 15 | (f) a directorship or officership in a business. |
| 16 | (7) "Public employee" means: |
| 17 | (a) any temporary or permanent employee of the state; |
| 18 | (b) any temporary or permanent employee of a local government; |
| 19 | (c) a member of a quasi-judicial board or commission or of a board, commission, or committee with |
| 20 | rulemaking authority; and |
| 21 | (d) a person under contract to the state. |
| 22 | (8) "Public officer" includes any state officer and any elected officer of a local government. |
| 23 | (9) "Special district" means a unit of local government, authorized by law to perform a single function |
| 24 | or a limited number of functions. The term includes but is not limited to conservation districts, water districts, |
| 25 | weed management districts, irrigation districts, fire districts, community college districts, hospital districts, sewer |
| 26 | districts, and transportation districts. The term also includes any district or other entity formed by interlocal |
| 27 | agreement. |
| 28 | (10) (a) "State agency" includes: |
| 29 | (i) the state; |
| 30 | (ii) the legislature and its committees; |
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| 1 | (iii) all executive departments, boards, commissions, committees, bureaus, and offices; |
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| 2 | (iv) the university system; and |
| 3 | (v) all independent commissions and other establishments of the state government. |
| 4 | (b) The term does not include the judicial branch. |
| 5 | (11) "State officer" includes all elected officers and directors of the executive branch of state government |
| 6 | as defined in 2-15-102." |
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| 8 | <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a |
| 9 | copy of [this act] to each tribal government located on the seven Montana reservations and to the Little Shell |
| 10 | band of Chippewa. |
