9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 76-13-201, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"76-13-201. Duty of owner to protect against fire. (1) An owner of land classified as forest land by
13	the department shall protect against the starting or existence and suppress the spread of fire on that land. This
14	protection and suppression must be in conformity with reasonable rules and standards for adequate fire
15	protection adopted by the department.
16	(2) If the owner does not provide for the protection and suppression, the department may provide it a
17	a cost to the landowner of not more than \$30 \$40 for each landowner in the protection district and of not more
18	than an additional 20 25 cents per acre per year for each acre in excess of 20 acres owned by each landowned
19	in each protection district, as necessary to yield the amount of money provided for in 76-13-207. The owner of
20	the land shall pay the charge approved by the department in accordance with part 1 and this part to the
21	department of revenue. Payments to the department of revenue are due on or before November 30 of each year
22	(3) Other charges may not be assessed to a participating landowner except in cases of proven proved
23	negligence on the part of the landowner or the landowner's agent."
