6 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ENCOURAGING HUNTING AND FISHING BY MONTANA YOUTH
7 BY PROVIDING THAT THE FIRST TIME A RESIDENT YOUTH WHO IS 12 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER AND
8 LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE APPLIES FOR A HUNTING LICENSE, THE YOUTH IS ENTITLED TO
9 RECEIVE A YOUTH COMBINATION SPORTS LICENSE FREE OF CHARGE; AMENDING SECTION 87-2-805,
10 MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

14 **Section 1.** Section 87-2-805, MCA, is amended to read:

15 **"87-2-805. Persons under eighteen years of age -- youth combination sports license.** (1) Resident
16 minors who are 12 years of age or older and under 15 years of age may fish and may hunt upland game and
17 migratory game birds during the open season with only a conservation license. Resident minors who are 15
18 years of age may hunt migratory game birds with only a conservation license. Resident minors who are under
19 12 years of age may fish without a license. A nonresident person under 15 years of age may not fish in or on
20 any Montana waters without first having obtained a Class B or B-4 fishing license unless the nonresident person
21 under 15 years of age is in the company of an adult in possession of a valid Montana fishing license. The limit
22 of fish for the nonresident person and the accompanying adult combined may not exceed the limit for one adult
23 as established by law or by rule of the department.

24 (2) A resident, as defined by 87-2-102, under 15 years of age may purchase Class A-3 and A-5 licenses
25 at a price equal to one-half the fee paid by a resident who is 15 years of age or older and under 62 years of age.

26 (3) (a) A resident who is 12 years of age or older and under 18 years of age may purchase a youth
27 combination sports license at a price that, rounded to the nearest dollar, is 46% of the fee paid for the Class AAA
28 combination sports license by a resident who is 18 years of age or older and under 62 years of age. A resident
29 who is 12 years of age or older and under 18 years of age and who applies for any hunting license for the first
30 time is entitled to receive a youth combination sports license free of charge.

- 1 (b) The youth combination sports license includes:
- 2 (i) a conservation license;
- 3 (ii) a fishing license;
- 4 (iii) an upland game bird license;
- 5 (iv) an elk license; and
- 6 (v) a deer license.
- 7 (c) A resident who is 15 years of age or older and under 18 years of age may purchase a Class A fishing
- 8 license at a price that is 50% of the fee paid by a resident who is 18 years of age or older and under 62 years
- 9 of age.
- 10 (d) A resident who is 15 years of age or older and under 18 years of age may purchase a Class A-1
- 11 upland game bird license at 50% of the fee paid by a resident who is 18 years of age or older and under 62 years
- 12 of age.
- 13 (e) A person who lawfully purchases ~~a~~ or is granted a free youth combination sports license at 17 years
- 14 of age, but who reaches 18 years of age during that license year, may legally use the license during that license
- 15 year. A person who hunts or fishes using a youth combination sports license purchased or granted free after the
- 16 person reaches 18 years of age is guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be subject to any of the following penalties
- 17 by the sentencing court:
- 18 (i) revocation of the person's hunting and fishing privileges for at least 5 years, revocation of the
- 19 person's hunting and fishing privileges for more than 5 years, or revocation of the person's hunting and fishing
- 20 privileges for life; and
- 21 (ii) a monetary fine of not less than \$500 and not more than \$5,000 in addition to the fine imposed on
- 22 a person under this chapter for the specific hunting or fishing violation.
- 23 (f) This section does not prohibit a resident minor from purchasing any individual licenses for which the
- 24 minor may be eligible under this chapter if the minor does not purchase the youth combination sports license."

26 **NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective May 1, 2003.
