8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 7-4-2110, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"7-4-2110. Supervision of county and other officers. The board of county commissioners has
12	jurisdiction and power, under such the limitations and restrictions as that are prescribed by law, to:
13	(1) supervise the official conduct of all elected and appointed county officers and officers of all districts
14	and other subdivisions of the county charged with assessing, collecting, safekeeping, management managing,
15	or <del>disbursement of the</del> <u>disbursing</u> public <del>revenues</del> <u>revenue</u> ;
16	(2) see that they the officers faithfully perform their duties;
17	(3) direct prosecutions for delinquencies; and
18	(4) when necessary, require them the officers to renew their official bonds, make reports, and present
19	their books and accounts for inspection; and
20	(5) require the officers to adhere to SUPERVISE STAFF IN A MANNER THAT COMPLIES WITH personnel policies
21	and procedures adopted by the county governing body."
