9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 7-6-2401, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"7-6-2401. Creation of office of county auditor. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the The
13	office of county auditor exists in all counties of the first, second, third, or fourth class and having a population
14	<u>in excess of 15,000</u> .
15	(2) The provisions of 7-6-2401 through 7-6-2413 do not apply to County commissioners in counties
16	having a population of less than 15,000 persons according to the most recent federal census to which subsection
17	(1) does not apply may create a county auditor's position, either as a full-time or a part-time position or in
18	combination with another position pursuant to 7-4-2301.
19	(3) The provisions of 7-6-2403 through 7-6-2412 do not apply to counties that do not have county
20	auditors."
