8	WHEREAS, local ombudsman services a	re an integral part of pr	oviding a wide range of services for	
9	older Montana citizens as mandated by the Older A	ler Montana citizens as mandated by the Older Americans Act of 1965, as amended, and the Montana Older		
10	Americans Act, Title 52, chapter 3, part 5; and			
11	WHEREAS, according to the 2000 Census	WHEREAS, according to the 2000 Census, the population of rural Montana has increased to 117,239,		
12	and 15,329 or 1.7% of elderly residents are over 85 years of age; and			
13	WHEREAS, Montanans over 65 years of age account for 13.41% of the population and that percentage			
14	will only increase as the Baby Boom generation, those born between 1946 and 1964, reaches retirement age;			
15	and			
16	WHEREAS, the availability and access to services is diminishing as more and more Montanans are			
17	reaching 65 years of age and becoming eligible for Medicare and Medicaid; and			
18	WHEREAS, residents of long-term care facilities and their family members require assistance in dealing			
19	with problems of daily care, quality of life, and resident's rights; and			
20	WHEREAS, the best way to provide assistance is at the local level by trained persons such as the			
21	ombudsmen who are in the facilities on a regular basis and who may be called to private assisted living facilities,			
22	group homes, and private homes; and			
23	WHEREAS, there is a need for monitoring caretakers, such as family and nursing homes, so that the			
24	elderly have someone to whom they can report any abuse without fear of retaliation; and			
25	WHEREAS, the need for information on ombudsman services for the elderly is necessary in maintaining			
26	the quality of care and life of Montanan's aging population.
