10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Restoration and rehabilitation of county courthouses. (1) The historic
13	preservation officer shall implement a county courthouse restoration and rehabilitation program. At the request
14	of a board of county commissioners, the historic preservation officer shall, in consultation with the appropriate
15	county officials:
16	(1)(A) evaluate the current condition of the county courthouse and determine whether restoration or
17	rehabilitation is necessary or warranted;
18	(2)(B) estimate costs that may be associated with the restoration or rehabilitation activities;
19	(3)(C) provide technical assistance to the counties as requested; and
20	(4)(D) provide assistance to the counties in obtaining government and private sector grants and loans
21	to assist counties in paying for courthouse restoration or rehabilitation projects.
22	(2) The historic preservation officer shall contract with a historical architect to assist
23	COUNTIES IN RESTORING AND REHABILITATING COUNTY COURTHOUSES. THE CONTRACT MAY NOT EXCEED \$72,000.

25	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
26	integral part of Title 22, chapter 3, part 4, and the provisions of Title 22, chapter 3, part 4, apply to [section 1].
