6	TO HOLD QUARTERLY MEETINGS INSTEAD OF FOUR MEETINGS IN SPECIFIC MONTHS; AMENDING
7	SECTION 20-3-322, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	Section 1. Section 20-3-322, MCA, is amended to read:
12	"20-3-322. Meetings and quorum. (1) The trustees of a district shall hold at least the following number
13	of regular meetings:
14	(a) an organization meeting, as prescribed by 20-3-321;
15	(b) a final budget meeting, as prescribed by 20-9-131; and
16	(c) in first-class elementary districts, not less than one regular meeting each month; or
17	(d) in any other district, regular meetings during the months of April, August, October, and January at
18	<u>least quarterly</u> .
19	(2) The trustees of the district shall adopt a policy setting the day and time for the minimum number of
20	regular school meetings prescribed in subsection (1)(c) or (1)(d) and, in addition, any other regular meeting days
21	the trustees wish to establish. Except for an unforeseen emergency, meetings must be conducted in school
22	buildings or in a publicly owned building located within the district.
23	(3) Special meetings of the trustees may be called by the presiding officer or any two members of the
24	trustees by giving each member a 48-hour written notice of the meeting, except that the 48-hour notice is waived
25	in an unforeseen emergency.
26	(4) Business may not be transacted by the trustees of a district unless it is transacted at a regular
27	meeting or a properly called special meeting. A quorum for any meeting is a majority of the trustees'
28	membership. All trustee meetings must be public meetings, as prescribed by 2-3-201, except that the trustees
29	may recess to an executive session under the provisions of 2-3-203.
30	(5) For the purposes of subsection (3), "unforeseen emergency" means a storm, fire, explosion,

- 3 functions of the district."
