4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO ISSUE A DECAL
5	BEARING THE SYMBOL OF A PERSON WITH A DISABILITY TO A QUALIFYING PERSON WHO COMBINES
6	TO COMBINE THE APPLICATION FOR THE DECAL WITH AN APPLICATION FOR A SPECIAL LICENSE
7	PLATE WITH AN APPLICATION FOR A LICENSE PLATE BEARING THE SYMBOL OF A PERSON WITH A
8	DISABILITY; PROVIDING THAT THE DEPARTMENT PRESCRIBE WHERE THE DECAL MUST BE AFFIXED
9	ON THE SPECIAL LICENSE PLATE; COORDINATING SPECIAL PARKING PERMIT LAWS WITH THE
10	ISSUANCE OF A DECAL; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 49-4-301, 49-4-302, 49-4-304, 61-3-332, AND 61-3-426
11	AND AMENDING SECTION 61-3-479, MCA."

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
14	(Refer to Introduced Bill)
15	Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert:

17	Section 1. Section 61-3-479, MCA, is amended to read:
18	"61-3-479. (Temporary) Special certificate of registration and issuance of generic specialty
19	license plates qualifications. (1) The department shall issue a special certificate of registration and generic
20	specialty license plates to a person who applies if the person presents written certification, in a form prescribed
21	by the department, from the sponsoring organization indicating that the person is eligible to receive the generic
22	specialty license plates.
23	(2) If the sponsor is a governmental body that has a written agreement with the county treasurer
24	pursuant to 61-3-480, the department shall issue a special certificate of registration and generic specialty license
25	plates to an eligible person who applies if the person pays the donation specified by the governmental body to
26	the county treasurer at the time of application.
27	(3) A special certificate of registration and generic specialty license plates may be issued only for a light
28	vehicle.
29	(4) The department may issue a special certificate of registration and generic specialty license plates
30	to joint owners of a motor vehicle if one of the owners is determined by the sponsor to be eligible and if the

1 eligible owner's name appears on the vehicle's special certificate of registration.

(5) (a) Except as provided in 61-3-472 through 61-3-481, a person who receives a special certificate
of registration and generic specialty license plates is subject to the same rules and laws as those that govern
number plates.

- (b) Except as provided in 61-3-472 through 61-3-481, the department is subject to the same rules and
 laws as govern the issuance of number plates.
- 7 (c) Generic specialty license plates issued under 61-3-472 through 61-3-481 are not subject to the
 8 maximum 4-year limitation provided in 61-3-332(3)(a).
- 9 (6) A person may combine an application for a generic specialty license plate with an application for
- 10 a license plate with a design bearing a representation of a wheelchair as the symbol of a person with a disability
- 11 <u>as provided in 61-3-332(10)(g).</u> (Terminates June 30, 2005--sec. 21, Ch. 402, L. 2001.)"
