BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-7-118, MCA, is amended to read:
"61-7-118. Penalty for violation. (1) A person violating any provision of 61-7-104 through 61-7-110 or 61-7-112 through 61-7-114 is guilly of a misdemeanor. Upon a first convietion, the offender shallbe punished by a fine of not less than $\$ 10 \$ 200$ or more than $\$ 100 \$ 300$ or by imprisonment for net more than 1020 days. For a seeondeonvietion within 1 year thereafter of the first convietion, the offender shallbe punished by a fine ef not less than $\$ 25 \$ 300$ or more than $\$ 200 \$ 400$, or by imprisonment for not more than 2030 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Upon a third or subsequent convietion within 1 year of the first convietion, an effender shall be punished by a fine of not less than $\$ 50 \$ 400$ or more than $\$ 500_{2}$ or by imprisonment for not more than 6 months ${ }_{2}$ or by both such fine-and imprisonment.


 4 YEAR THEREAFIER, THE OFFENDERSHALL BE PUHSHED BY A FINE OF NOTLESS THAN \$25 ORMORE THAN \$2000RBY


 (2) A PERSONCONVICTED UNDER61-7-104 THROUGH 617 - 106 SHALL BE FINED AN AMOUNT NOT TOEXCEEQ $\$ 500$ OR BE MMPAISONED FOR NOT MORE THAN 30 DAYS, OR BOTH.
(1) A PERSON VIOLATING ANY PROVISION OF 61-7-104 THROUGH 61-7-110 OR 61-7-112 THROUGH 61-7-114 IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR. UPON A FIRST CONVICTION, THE OFFENDER SHALL BE PUNISHED BY A FINE OF NOT LESS tHAN $\$ 200$ OR MORE THAN $\$ 300$ OR BY IMPRISONMENT FOR NOT MORE THAN 20 DAYS. FOR A SECOND CONVICTION

6 imprisoned in the county jail in the county in which the offense was committed, and the punishment shall be 7 commuted at the rate of 1 day's incarceration for each $\$ 10 \$ 20$ of the fine."
