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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	Section 1. Section 37-3-304, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"37-3-304. Practice authorized by temporary certificate. (1) The <u>A</u> temporary certificate, which may
12	be issued to any citizen or to an alien otherwise qualified for a physician's certificate and which may be issued
13	for a period not to exceed 1 year, subject to renewal for additional periods of 1 year but not to exceed five such
14	renewals, at the discretion of the board, authorizes the holder to perform one or more of the acts embraced listed
15	in 37-3-102(6) in a manner reasonably consistent with his the holder's training, skill, and experience, subject,
16	nevertheless, to all specifications, conditions, and limitations imposed by the board.
17	(2) A temporary certificate may not be issued for a period that exceeds 1 year. However, except as
18	provided in subsection (3), a temporary certificate may be renewed, at the board's discretion, for additional
19	1-year periods, but may not be renewed more than five times.
20	(3) A person meeting the requirements of 37-3-305(5) may be granted a limited temporary certificate
21	for a period of 3 months, which may be extended at the board's discretion upon a showing of good cause for a
22	period not to exceed 3 months."

24	Section 2. Section 37-3-305, MCA, is amended to read:
25	"37-3-305. Qualifications for licensure. (1) Except as provided in subsection subsections (4) and (5),
26	a person may not be granted a physician's license to practice medicine in this state unless the person:
27	(a) is of good moral character, as determined by the board;
28	(b) is a graduate of an approved medical school as defined in 37-3-102;
29	(c) has completed an approved postgraduate program of at least 2 years or, in the opinion of the board,
30	has had experience or training that is at least the equivalent of a 2-year postgraduate program;
