8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Standards for communication. (1) The department shall develop, by
11	administrative rule, standards for the professional conduct of all employees for communication with Indian triba
12	governments, recipients of departmental services, providers of services under contract with the department, and
13	the general public.
14	(2) Standards must be developed regarding how department employees:
15	(a) solicit, incorporate, or respond to information received on any contemplated changes in services of
16	benefits in department programs;
17	(b) proceed in contract negotiations, department audits of providers or services, and quality
18	management activities; and
19	(c) are required to conduct themselves in an open, fair, objective, and impartial manner.
20	(3) Standards must include a requirement that all employees receive training on the standards during
21	the first 90 days of employment or, for those already employed, within 6 months of the adoption of the rules.
22	(4) The rules must describe how the department will implement oversight and evaluation of employees
23	to ensure that training is completed and that all employees follow standards of professional conduct in
24	communication on an ongoing basis.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
27	integral part of Title 2, chapter 15, part 22, and the provisions of Title 2, chapter 15, part 22, apply to [section 1]
28	
29	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Notification to tribal governments. The secretary of state shall send a
30	copy of [this act] to each tribal government located on the seven Montana reservations and to the Little Shel
