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8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. ANB for students in certain facilities. A school district with a CHILD CARE
11	AGENCY-residential treatment center FACILITY for school-aged children located within the district's boundaries
12	may include a student in the treatment center in the district's ANB ENROLLMENT count A STUDENT WHO IS UNDER
13	THE PROTECTIVE CARE OF A STATE AGENCY OR HAS BEEN ADJUDICATED BY A MONTANA COURT TO BE A YOUTH IN NEED
14	OF INTERVENTION OR A DELINQUENT YOUTH, AS DEFINED IN 41-5-103, OR A STUDENT WHO IS REQUIRED TO ATTEND
15	SCHOOL OUTSIDE OF THE DISTRICT OF RESIDENCE AS THE RESULT OF A PLACEMENT IN FOSTER CARE OR IN A GROUP HOME
16	LICENSED BY THE STATE if:
17	(1) THE CHILD-CARE AGENCYRESIDENTIAL TREATMENT CENTER FACILITY IS LICENSED BY THE STATE AS A YOUTH
18	GROUP HOME THAT PROVIDES THERAPEUTIC SERVICES;
19	(1)(2) the district retains written verification from the CHILD-CARE AGENCY—residential treatment center
20	FACILITY documenting the student's participation in the CHILD-CARE AGENCYRESIDENTIAL treatment center's
21	FACILITY'S education program on the date that enrollment is counted;
22	(2)(3) the CHILD-CARE AGENCY-residential treatment center has applied for accreditation for its education
23	program from the board of public education;
24	$\frac{(3)(4)}{(3)}$ all of the teachers in the <u>CHILD-CARE AGENCY-residential treatment center's FACILITY'S</u> education
25	program are certified, as provided in 20-4-101; AND
26	(4) the residential treatment center is licensed by the state as a youth group home that provides
27	therapeutic services; and
28	(5)(4) the school district has entered into a contractual agreement with the CHILD-CARE AGENCY
29	residential treatment center FACILITY to provide educational services to the students in the center.
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1	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
2	integral part of Title 20, chapter 9, part 3, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter 9, part 3, apply to [section 1].

4	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date applicability. [This act] is effective July 1, 2003, AND
5	APPLIES TO SCHOOL BUDGETS FOR SCHOOL FISCAL YEARS BEGINNING ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2003.
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7	NEW SECTION. Section 4. Termination. [This act] terminates June 30, 2005.
