8	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE DISABILITY RETIREMENT BENEFIT OF A
9	MEMBER OF THE HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS' RETIREMENT SYSTEM IF THE MEMBER'S DISABILITY
10	IS A DIRECT RESULT OF ANY SERVICE TO THE MONTANA HIGHWAY PATROL IN THE LINE OF DUTY;
11	AMENDING SECTION 19-6-601, MCA; PROVIDING CONTINGENT VOIDNESS; AND PROVIDING AN

14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

16	Section 1. Section 19-6-601, MCA, is amended to read:
17	"19-6-601. Disability retirement benefit. (1) In the case of the disability of a member, a disability
18	retirement benefit must be granted the member that is the actuarial equivalent of the service retirement benefit
19	under 19-6-502 standing to the member's credit at the time of the member's disability retirement. If the disability
20	is a direct result of any service to the Montana highway patrol in the line of duty, then the member who is
21	disabled must be retired on a disability retirement benefit $\underline{\text{equal to }80\%}$ of $\underline{\text{one-half}}$ the member's highest averaged
22	compensation regardless of the member's length of service.
23	(2) Upon the death of a retired member receiving a disability retirement benefit as provided in
24	subsection (1), the benefit must be paid to the member's surviving spouse or dependent child, if there is a
25	spouse or child, in the same manner as provided for in 19-6-505(2) and (3)."

27	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Contingent voidness. If House Bill No. 206 is not passed and approved,
28	THEN [THIS ACT] IS VOID.

30	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 2003.
