8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 22-1-1103, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"22-1-1103. Nondisclosure of library records legislative findings. (1) No A person may not release
12	or disclose a library record or portion of a library record to any person except in response to:
13	(a) a written request of the person identified in that record, according to procedures and forms giving
14	written consent as determined by the library; or
15	(b) a written request of the parent or legal guardian of an individual who is less than 18 years of age
16	and who is identified in that record, according to procedures and forms giving written consent as determined by
17	the library; or
18	(b)(c) an order issued by a court of competent jurisdiction, upon a finding that the disclosure of such
19	$\underline{\text{the}}\text{record}\text{is necessary}\text{because the merits of public disclosure clearly exceed the demand for individual privacy}.$
20	(2) A library is not prevented from publishing or making available to the public reasonable statistical
21	reports regarding library registration and book circulation if those reports are presented so that <del>no</del> <u>an</u> individual
22	is <u>not</u> identified <del>therein</del> <u>in the reports</u> .
23	(3) Library records may be disclosed to the extent necessary to return overdue or stolen materials or
24	collect fines.
25	(4) The legislature finds that it will enhance the protection of children to allow parents and guardians
26	to have knowledge of materials accessed by their children or wards in order to discuss those materials and give
27	guidance to their children or wards."
