- 5 (c) upon a one-way street, or upon any roadway on which traffic is restricted to one direction of movement, where the roadway is free from obstructions and of sufficient width for two or more lines of moving vehicles.
  - (2) The driver operator of a vehicle may overtake and pass another vehicle upon the right only under conditions permitting such the movement in safety. In no event shall such The movement may not be made by driving off the pavement or main-traveled portion of the roadway."
