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12	Section 1. Section 45-5-221, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"45-5-221. Malicious intimidation or harassment relating to civil or human rights penalty. (1)
14	A person commits the offense of malicious intimidation or harassment when, because of another person's race
15	creed, religion, color, national origin, or involvement in civil rights or human rights activities, he the person
16	purposely or knowingly, with the intent to terrify, intimidate, threaten, or harass, annoy, or offend:
17	(a) causes bodily injury to another;
18	(b) causes reasonable apprehension of bodily injury in another; or
19	(c) damages, destroys, or defaces any property of another or any public property.
20	(2) For purposes of this section, "deface" includes but is not limited to cross burning or the placing of
21	any word or symbol commonly associated with racial, religious, or ethnic identity or activities on the property of
22	another person without his or her permission.
23	(3)(2) A person convicted of the offense of malicious intimidation or harassment shall be imprisoned
24	in the state prison for a term not to exceed 5 years or be fined an amount not to exceed \$5,000, or both."
