5	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING AN INCREASED PENSION BENEFIT TO MEMBERS
6	UNDER THE VOLUNTEER FIREFIGHTERS' COMPENSATION ACT WHO HAVE COMPLETED MORE THAN
7	20 YEARS OF SERVICE; AMENDING SECTIONS 19-17-401 AND 19-17-404, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
8	EFFECTIVE DATE."

10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
11	
12	Section 1. Section 19-17-401, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"19-17-401. Eligibility for pension and disability benefits. (1) To qualify for a full pension, partial
14	pension, and or disability benefits benefit under this chapter, a member shall meet the requirements of
15	subsections (2) or (3) and (4).
16	(2) (a) For <u>a</u> full pension <del>benefits</del> <u>benefit</u> , a member must have completed <del>at least</del> 20 <del>years'</del> <u>years of</u>
17	service and must have attained 55 years of age, but need not be an active member of a fire company when 55
18	years of age is reached.
19	(b) A member who is prevented from completing at least 20 years' years of service may qualify for a
20	partial pension <del>benefits <u>benefit</u> if the member has completed at least 10 <del>years' <u>years of</u> service and has attained</del></del>
21	60 years of age, but need not be an active member of any fire company when 60 years of age is reached.
22	(3) An active member of a fire company whose duty-related injury results in permanent total disability,
23	as defined in 39-71-116 and determined pursuant to 19-17-410, is eligible, regardless of age or service, to
24	receive a disability benefit.
25	(4) Except as provided in subsection (5):
26	(a) to receive a pension or disability benefit, a volunteer firefighter may not be an active member of any
27	fire company; and
28	(b) a volunteer firefighter who receives a pension or disability benefit under this chapter may not
29	become an active member of any fire company.
30	(5) In the event of a declared national, state, or local emergency affecting Montana, a retired volunteer

2 company for the duration of the declared emergency without becoming an active member under the Volunteer 3 Firefighters' Compensation Act and the volunteer firefighters' pension plan and without loss of previously earned 4 benefits. Only the fire chief of the fire company may determine who may return to active service. The fire chief 5 shall prescribe the duties of any retired volunteer firefighter returning to active service." 6 7 Section 2. Section 19-17-404, MCA, is amended to read: 8 "19-17-404. Amount of pension and disability benefits. (1) (a) Each eligible member must receive 9 a pension and or disability benefits benefit as provided in this section. 10 (b)(2) (a) The base Except as provided in subsection (2)(c), the full pension benefit paid to eligible 11 members is \$150 a month for members who are eligible for full pension benefits. 12 (c)(b) Partial A partial pension benefits are benefit is calculated by multiplying the full pension benefit in subsection (1)(b) (2)(a) by a fraction, the numerator of which is the eligible member's years of service and the 13 14 denominator of which is 20. 15 (c) The full pension benefit of a member who has completed 20 years of service and is at least 55 years 16 of age, but no more than 65 years of age, and who continues to be an active member must be increased by 17 \$7.50 a month for each additional year of active service UP TO 30 TOTAL YEARS OF SERVICE. 18 (2)(3) The disability benefit paid to an eligible members member is calculated in the same manner as 19 partial pension benefits described in subsection (1)(c) (2)(b), except that the numerator may not be less than 20 10. 21 (3)(4) If any fraudulent change or any inadvertent mistake in records results in any member, surviving 22 spouse, or dependent child receiving more or less than entitled to, then on the discovery of the error, the board 23 shall correct the error and adjust the payments to the member, surviving spouse, or dependent child in an
