9	A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA SUPPORTING
10	MONTANA'S ARMED FORCES PERSONNEL IN OPERATION IRAQI FREEDOM.

12	WHEREAS, more than 1,000 armed forces personnel from the State of Montana are presently in the
13	Persian Gulf region; and
14	WHEREAS, Montanans in the Persian Gulf region are serving in the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine
15	Corps, <u>COAST GUARD,</u> and National Guard in a wide variety of duty assignments; and
16	WHEREAS, Montanans have a long and distinguished heritage of service to our nation in times of
17	military conflict; and
18	WHEREAS, the brave personnel from our state are continuing the Montana tradition of commitment and
19	sacrifice at their duty stations in the Persian Gulf region; and
20	WHEREAS, those called up to support bases and protect cities here in the United States and in foreign
21	countries are performing essential activities and are replacing troops sent to the Middle East; and
22	WHEREAS, the families of the service personnel are contributing by keeping the home fires burning.

24	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
25	MONTANA:
26	(1) That the Montana Legislature express the deep feeling of all Montanans in this affirmation of support
27	and gratitude to the courageous service personnel from Montana now assigned to the current operation in the
28	Persian Gulf.
29	(2) That it is the hope of the people of Montana that:
30	(a) the mission of the forces in the Persian Gulf region be accomplished quickly and that Montanans

1 and other service personnel serving in the current operation will soon return home safely;

(b) long-lasting peace be brought to the nation of Iraq with a minimum loss of life to members of our
Armed Forces and to the innocent civilians in the region; and

4 (c) when making decisions of war and peace in the current operation, our Commander-in-Chief be
5 guided by wisdom and good judgment.

6 (3) That the Secretary of State send copies of this resolution to the Montana Congressional Delegation 7 and to Montana service personnel in the Persian Gulf region informing them that the heartfelt thanks of all 8 Montana are extended to them, that we are proud of them, that they are in our prayers, and that we send them 9 best wishes for a safe return.
