7	HIGHWAY PATROL OFFICERS', GAME WARDENS' AND PEACE OFFICERS', MUNICIPAL POLICE
8	OFFICERS', AND FIREFIGHTERS' UNIFIED RETIREMENT SYSTEM MUST HAVE AT LEAST 10 YEARS OF
9	SERVICE CREDIT TO SYSTEMS MAY PURCHASE MILITARY SERVICE; PROVIDING THAT MEMBERS OF
10	THE JUDGES' RETIREMENT SYSTEM MAY PURCHASE MILITARY SERVICE; PROVIDING THAT ANY
11	VESTED MEMBER OF THE SYSTEM MAY PURCHASE THE SERVICE; AMENDING SECTION SECTIONS
12	19-3-503, <u>19-6-801, 19-7-803, 19-7-804, 19-8-901, 19-9-403, AND 19-13-403,</u> MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
13	IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

17	Section 1. Section 19-3-503, MCA, is amended to read:
18	"19-3-503. Application to purchase military service. (1) (a) Except as provided in subsection (2) and
19	subject to 19-3-514, a vested member with at least 10 years of service credit <u>WITH AT LEAST 5 YEARS OF</u>
20	MEMBERSHIP SERVICE may, at any time prior to retirement, file a written application with the board to purchase
21	service credit for up to 5 years of the member's active service in the armed forces of the United States, including
22	the first special service force or the American merchant marine in oceangoing service during the period of armed
23	conflict, December 7, 1941, to August 15, 1945.

	(b) To purchase this service, the member shall pay the actuarial cost of the member's military service,

SECTION 2. SECTION 19-6-801, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:

"19-6-801. Application to purchase military service. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section
and subject to 19-6-805, a <u>an eligible</u> member with at least 15 years of service credit may, at any time prior to
retirement, file a written application with the board to purchase up to 5 years of the member's active service in
the armed forces of the United States for the purpose of calculating retirement benefits.

(2) To purchase this military service:

9 (a) a member with at least 15 years of service credit and who is not covered by 19-6-710 shall contribute 10 the amount determined by the board to be due based on the member's compensation and regular contribution 11 rate in the member's 16th year for the 1st year purchased and, for each subsequent year purchased, an amount 12 based on the member's compensation and contribution rate in each of as many years succeeding the member's 13 16th year as are required to complete the purchase, with regular interest from the date the member becomes 14 eligible for this benefit to the date the purchase is complete. The member may not purchase more military 15 service under this subsection (2)(a) than the member has service credit in excess of 15 years.

- (b) a member with at least 5 years of membership service and who is covered by 19-6-710 shall pay
 the actuarial cost of the member's military service, based on the system's most recent actuarial valuation.
- 18 (3) A member is not eligible to purchase military service under this section if the member:

(a) has retired from active duty in the armed forces of the United States with military retirement benefits
based on that military service;

SECTION 3. SECTION 19-7-803, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:

"19-7-803. Application to purchase military service. (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section and subject to 19-7-805, a member with at least 15 <u>5</u> years of <u>membership</u> service credit may, at any time prior to retirement, file a written application with the board to purchase up to 5 years of the member's active service in the armed forces of the United States for the purpose of calculating retirement benefits.

(2) To purchase this military service, the member shall pay the actuarial cost of the member's military
 service, based on the system's most recent actuarial valuation.

10	"19-7-804. Application to purchase additional service. (1) Subject to 19-7-805, a member with at
11	least 5 years of membership service may, at any time before retirement, file a written application with the board
12	to purchase 1 additional year of service credit for each 5 years of membership service.
13	(2) To purchase service under this section, a member shall pay the actuarial cost of the service in the
14	sheriffs' retirement system, as determined by the board, based on the system's most recent actuarial valuation.
15	(3) Service purchased under this section may not be used to qualify a member for the purchase of
16	military service under 19-7-803.
17	(4)(3) Service purchased under this section must be credited for the purpose of meeting retirement
18	eligibility and for calculating retirement benefits."

20	SECTION 5. SECTION 19-8-901, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
21	"19-8-901. Application to purchase military service. (1) (a) Except as otherwise provided in this
22	section and subject to 19-8-906, a member with at least 15 <u>5</u> years of <u>membership</u> service credit may, at any
23	time prior to retirement, file a written application with the board to purchase up to 5 years of the member's active
24	service in the armed forces of the United States for the purpose of calculating retirement benefits.

to retirement, file a written application with the board to purchase up to 5 years of the member's active duty
service in the armed forces of the United States for the purpose of calculating retirement benefits.

10 (3) The member may not purchase more military service than the member's years of membership
 11 service in excess of 15 years.

(1) (a) Except as otherwise provided in this 20 section and subject to 19-13-406, a member with at least 15 <u>5</u> years of <u>membership</u> service credit may, at any 21 time prior to retirement, file a written application with the board to purchase up to 5 years of the member's active 22 duty service in the armed forces of the United States for the purpose of calculating retirement benefits.
- (b) To purchase this military service, the member shall pay the actuarial cost of the service, based onthe system's most recent actuarial valuation.

5	NEW SECTION. Section 8. Application to purchase military service credit. (1) Except as
6	OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS SECTION AND SUBJECT TO [SECTION 9], A MEMBER WITH AT LEAST 5 YEARS OF MEMBERSHIP
7	SERVICE MAY, AT ANY TIME PRIOR TO RETIREMENT, FILE A WRITTEN APPLICATION WITH THE BOARD TO PURCHASE UP TO
8	5 YEARS OF THE MEMBER'S ACTIVE SERVICE IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES FOR THE PURPOSE OF
9	CALCULATING RETIREMENT BENEFITS.
10	(2) TO PURCHASE THIS MILITARY SERVICE, THE MEMBER SHALL PAY THE ACTUARIAL COST OF THE SERVICE,
11	BASED ON THE SYSTEM'S MOST RECENT ACTUARIAL VALUATION.
12	(3) A MEMBER IS NOT ELIGIBLE TO PURCHASE MILITARY SERVICE UNDER THIS SECTION IF THE MEMBER:
13	(A) HAS RETIRED FROM ACTIVE DUTY IN THE ARMED FORCES OF THE UNITED STATES WITH MILITARY RETIREMENT
14	BENEFITS BASED ON THAT MILITARY SERVICE;
15	(B) IS ELIGIBLE, PURSUANT TO 19-2-707, TO RECEIVE CREDIT IN THE SYSTEM FOR THAT SERVICE; OR
16	(C) IS ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE CREDIT FOR THAT SERVICE IN ANY OTHER RETIREMENT SYSTEM OR PLAN.

18	NEW SECTION. Section 9. Service purchase limitation. A member may not purchase more than a
19	COMBINED TOTAL OF 5 YEARS OF SERVICE UNDER 19-5-409 AND [SECTION 8].
20	
21	NEW SECTION. SECTION 10. CODIFICATION INSTRUCTION. [SECTIONS 8 AND 9] ARE INTENDED TO BE
22	CODIFIED AS AN INTEGRAL PART OF TITLE 19, CHAPTER 5, PART 4, AND THE PROVISIONS OF TITLE 19, CHAPTER 5, PART
23	4, APPLY TO [SECTIONS 8 AND 9].

25	NEW SECTION. Section 11. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval JULY 1,
26	<u>2003</u> .
