9	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Rulemaking authority. The department may adopt rules to implement
12	the provisions of this chapter. The rules may include but are not limited to:
13	(1) establishing procedures to evaluate and make determinations on requests for a variation of the basic
14	or enhanced 9-1-1 service;
15	(2) establishing evaluation criteria for basic and enhanced 9-1-1 systems plans;
16	(3) establishing requirements for program participation by public and private safety agencies;
17	(4) establishing guidelines for the distribution of funds; and
18	(5) specifying reporting requirements.

20	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
21	integral part of Title 10, chapter 4, part 1, and the provisions of Title 10, chapter 4, part 1, apply to [section 1].

23	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
