10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Purchase of federal volunteer service. (1) Subject to 19-3-514, a
13	member with at least 5 years of membership service may, at any time prior to retirement, file a written application
14	with the board to purchase membership service AND SERVICE credit for up to 5 years of the member's service as
15	a volunteer in a United States service program, such as the peace corps, americorps, or the freedom corps
16	SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF A TERM OF SERVICE IN A NATIONAL SERVICE POSITION AS DESCRIBED IN THE NATIONAL AND
17	COMMUNITY SERVICE ACT OF 1990, 42 U.S.C. 12501, ET SEQ.
18	(2) Purchase of membership service AND SERVICE credit under this section is subject to the retirement
19	board's verification of the member's <u>VOLUNTEER</u> service.
20	(3) To purchase this membership service AND SERVICE credit, the member shall pay the actuarial cost
21	of the service credit, based on the system's most recent actuarial valuation.

23	Section 2. Section 19-3-514, MCA, is amended to read:
24	"19-3-514. Service purchase limit exception. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), a member
25	may not purchase more than a combined total of 5 years under 19-3-503, 19-3-511(3)(b), 19-3-512, and
26	19-3-513 <u>, and [section 1]</u> .
27	(2) A member who has purchased service <u>CREDIT</u> under 19-3-503 or 19-3-512 on or before January 1,
28	1990, and who elects to purchase service <u>CREDIT</u> under 19-3-513 must receive credit for the full months of
29	service purchased on or before January 1, 1990."
