| 10 | NEW SECTION. Section 1. Article IV of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended by |
| 11 | adding a new section 9 that reads: |
| 12 | Section 9. Term limits for supreme court. (1) A person may not serve more than two consecutive |
| 13 | terms as a supreme court justice. A term served as chief justice or justice shall count the same for computation |
| 14 | of judicial term limits. Service as an appointee to a vacancy for any portion of an 8-year term shall count as one |
| 15 | term for computation of judicial term limits. |
| 16 | (2) Except for write-in candidates, a candidate shall not file for nomination or election to a term of judicial |
| 17 | office that exceeds the limits set in subsection (1). |
| 18 | (3) Nothing contained in this section precludes an otherwise qualified candidate from being certified as |
| 19 | nominated or elected by virtue of write-in votes cast for the candidate. |

| 21 | NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date applicability. If approved by the electorate, this |
| 22 | amendment is effective January 1, 2005, and applies to elections occurring during or after 2006. For purposes |
| 23 | of calculating terms of service for judicial term limits, the amendment does not apply to terms of service that |
| 24 | began prior to January 1, 2005, and those terms of service may not be included in a judicial term limits |
| 25 | computation. |
