

## SENATE BILL NO. 180

INTRODUCED BY D. RYAN, COBB, SCHMIDT, SHEA

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT MAKING PERMANENT THE PROVISION THAT ALLOWS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO LEAVES WORK OR IS DISCHARGED BECAUSE OF CIRCUMSTANCES RESULTING FROM DOMESTIC VIOLENCE TO RECEIVE UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS; REPEALING SECTION 6 4, CHAPTER 520, LAWS OF 2001; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Repealer.** Section 6 4, Chapter 520, Laws of 2001, is repealed.

NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Effective date.** [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
