6	CONSTITUTIONAL AND STATUTORY DUTIES; AND AMENDING SECTION 20-4-109, MCA."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 20-4-109, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"20-4-109. Fees for teacher and specialist certificates. (1) A person applying for the issuance or
12	renewal of a teacher or specialist certificate shall pay a fee not to exceed \$6 for each school fiscal year that the
13	certificate is valid. In addition to this fee, a person who has never held any class of Montana teacher or specialist
14	certificate or for whom an emergency authorization of employment has never been issued shall pay a filing fee
15	of \$6. The fees must be paid to the superintendent of public instruction, who shall deposit the fees with the state
16	treasurer to the credit of the state special revenue fund account, created in subsection (2), to be used in the
17	following manner:
18	(a) \$4 for expenses of the certification standards and practices advisory council created in 2-15-1522;
19	(b) \$2 to the board of public education to be used by and the certification standards and practices
20	advisory council for research in accordance with the activities in support of the constitutional and statutory duties
21	of the board of public education and the certification standards and practices advisory council provided for in
22	20-4-133 .
23	(2) There is an account in the state special revenue fund. Money from fees for teacher or specialist
24	certificates required in subsection (1) must be deposited in the account."
