| 13 | "Section 3. Election and terms. A member of the house of representatives shall be elected for a term |
| 14 | of two four years and a member of the senate for a term of four six years each to begin on a date provided by |
| 15 | law. One-half of the senators shall be elected every two years." |

| 17 | NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. This amendment is effective on approval by the electorate. |

| 19 | NEW SECTION. Section 3. Submission to electorate. This amendment shall be submitted to the |
| 20 | qualified electors of Montana at the general election to be held in November 2004 by printing on the ballot the |
| 21 | full title of this act and the following: |
| 22 | [] FOR extending the terms of legislators by two years and removing the requirement that one-half |
| 23 | of senators be elected every two years. |
| 24 | [] AGAINST extending the terms of legislators by two years and removing the requirement that |
| 25 | one-half of senators be elected every two years. |
