6	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROVIDING THAT A FORMER MEMBER OF THE
7	SELF-INSURERS GUARANTY FUND IS LIABLE FOR ASSESSMENTS MADE BY THE FUND IN ANY YEAR
8	FOLLOWING THE DATE THAT THE MEMBER'S STATUS AS A PRIVATE SELF-INSURER IS TERMINATED;
9	REQUIRING A FORMER MEMBER'S ASSESSMENT TO BE BASED ON BENEFITS PAID DURING THE LAST
10	CALENDAR YEAR IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE ANNUAL ASSESSMENT; AMENDING SECTION
11	39-71-2615, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15	Section 1. Section 39-71-2615, MCA, is amended to read:
16	"39-71-2615. Initial fee assessment. (1) A private self-insurer shall pay to the fund an initial fee of
17	\$1,000 upon becoming a member. Thereafter, a member's financial obligation to the fund must be established
18	by assessment as provided in subsection (2).
19	(2) (a) The fund may assess each of its members a pro rata share of the amount necessary to carry out
20	the purposes of this part. However, the total annual assessments in any calendar year may not exceed 5% of
21	the following benefits paid by each member during the preceding calendar year:
22	(i) compensation benefits; and
23	(ii) except for medical benefits in excess of \$200,000 for each occurrence that are exempt from
24	assessment, the total medical benefits paid for medical treatment rendered to an injured worker, including
25	hospital treatment and prescription drugs.
26	(b) Funds obtained by assessment pursuant to this subsection may be used only for the purposes of
27	this part.
28	(3) A former member is liable for assessments made by the fund for 3 years in any year following the
29	date the member's status as a private self-insurer is terminated, whether the termination is by action of the
30	private self-insurer or the department. A former member's assessment must be based on the benefits paid

during the last calendar year immediately preceding the termination of the member's status as a private self-insurer annual assessment.

(4) The board shall certify to the department the collection and receipt of assessments, noting any delinquencies. The board shall take appropriate action to collect a delinquent assessment."
