12	Section 1. Section 39-71-736, MCA, is amended to read:

14	$\underline{\text{subsection (2), compensation}}  \underline{\text{Compensation}}  \underline{\text{Compensation}}  \underline{\text{may not be paid for the first 40 }} \underline{\text{32}}  \underline{\text{hours or 5}}  \underline{\text{4}}  \underline{\text{days' loss of wages,}} \\$

22	that each day for which the worker elects to receive sick leave counts 1 day toward the 5-day 4-DAY waiting
23	period.
24	(3)(4)(3) Augmentation of temporary total disability benefits with sick leave by an employer pursuant
25	to a collective bargaining agreement may not disqualify a worker from receiving temporary total disability
26	benefits.
27	(4)(5)(4) Receipt of vacation leave by an injured worker may not affect the worker's eligibility for
28	temporary total disability benefits."
