8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 82-15-103, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"82-15-103. Standards for petroleum products. (1) The standards, and specifications, and official
12	tests for petroleum products, including but not limited to gasoline, fuel oils, diesel fuel, kerosene, and liquefied
13	petroleum gases, <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be determined <u>and established</u> by the department <u>by rule</u> and <del>shall</del> <u>must</u> be based
14	upon nationally recognized standards and specifications such as that are published from time to time by the
15	American society for testing and materials. When so determined by the department and adopted as rules, such
16	standards and specifications are the standards and specifications for such products sold in this state and official
17	tests of such products shall be based upon them.
18	(2) The department may not adopt by rule a minimum octane content standard for gasoline labeled
19	"unleaded" or "regular unleaded" that is less than 87.5."
20	
21	Section 2. Section 82-15-110, MCA, is amended to read:
22	"82-15-110. Unlawful acts. It is unlawful to:
23	(1) use any meter or mechanical device for the measurement of gasoline or liquid fuels unless the same
24	meter or device has been approved by the department and sealed as correct;
25	(2) change or in any way tamper with the department's seal without written consent from the
26	department;
27	(3) make hose delivery from petroleum vehicle tanks unless the tanks have been calibrated by the
28	department under 82-15-108;
29	(4) sell or deliver liquefied petroleum to a consumer as a liquid or vapor except as provided by
30	82-15-109;

(5) sell or offer for sale or deliver liquefied petroleum to a consumer as a liquid or vapor the
measurement of which has not been temperature corrected to 60 degrees F by means of an automatic
$compensating \ device \ \frac{which}{that} \ has \ been \ approved, \ calibrated, \ and \ sealed \ by \ the \ department, \ unless \ otherwise \ department, \ unless \ depar$
provided by the department;

- (6) sell, offer, or expose for sale any petroleum product for which standards or minimum specifications have been set by the department unless the commodities in all respects meet the tests and standards prescribed;
- (7) sell, offer, or expose for sale any petroleum product which that is adulterated, mislabeled, or misrepresented with respect to the use for which it is reasonably intended; or
- (8) sell, offer, or expose for sale gasoline labeled "unleaded" or "regular unleaded" that has an octane level that is less than 87.5."
