5	UNDER THE SANITATION IN SUBDIVISIONS LAWS; AMENDING SECTION 76-4-121, MCA; AND
6	PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	Section 1. Section 76-4-121, MCA, is amended to read:
11	"76-4-121. Restrictions on subdivision activities. A person may not dispose of any lot within a
12	subdivision, erect any facility for the supply of water or disposal of sewage or solid waste, erect any building or
13	shelter in a subdivision that requires facilities for the supply of water or disposal of sewage or solid waste, or
14	occupy any permanent buildings in a subdivision until the subdivision plat or certificate of survey subject to
15	review under this part has been accepted for filing by the county clerk and recorder in accordance with 76-4-122
16	and recorded pursuant to Title 70, chapter 21:
17	(1) a certificate of subdivision approval has been issued pursuant to 76-4-125 indicating that the
18	reviewing authority has approved the subdivision application and that the subdivision is not subject to a sanitary
19	restriction; or
20	(2) the governing body has provided certification pursuant to 76-4-127 that the subdivision is within a
21	jurisdictional area that has adopted a growth policy pursuant to chapter 1 of this title or within a first-class or
22	second-class municipality, as described in 7-1-4111, and will be provided with adequate municipal facilities and
23	adequate storm water drainage; OR
24	(3) THE SUBDIVISION IS OTHERWISE EXEMPT FROM REVIEW UNDER 76-4-125."
