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10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
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12	Section 1. Section 76-2-101, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"76-2-101. Planning and zoning commission and district. (1) Subject to the provisions of subsection
14	(5), whenever the public interest or convenience may require and upon petition of 60% all 85% of the affected
15	freeholders, the board of county commissioners may create a planning and zoning district and appoint a planning
16	and zoning commission consisting of seven members.
17	(2) A planning and zoning district may not be created in an area that has been zoned by an incorporated
18	city pursuant to 76-2-310 and 76-2-311.
19	(3) For the purposes of this part, the word "district" means any area that consists of not less than 40
20	acres.
21	(4) Except as provided in subsection (5), an action challenging the creation of a planning and zoning
22	district must begin within 5 years after the date of the order by the board of county commissioners creating the
23	district.
24	(5) If freeholders representing $50\%$ $35\%$ of the titled property ownership in the district protest the
25	establishment of the district within 30 days of its creation, the board of county commissioners may not create
26	the district. An area included in a district protested under this subsection may not be included in a zoning district
27	petition under this section for a period of 1 year."
