7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Monument preservation. (1) Prior to the time that a A public or private
10	entity or person engages SHALL, BEFORE ENGAGING in activity that will or is likely to disturb or destroy a monument
11	or the accessories to a monument, the entity or person shall engage a registered surveyor to REQUIRE THE
12	FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED BY A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR, AS DEFINED IN 37-67-101, OR A
13	QUALIFIED PERSON UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR:
14	(a) locate and reference the monument or the accessories to the monument; and
15	(b) file a corner record showing the location of the references to the monument or to the accessories
16	to the monument.
17	(2) Within 30 days after an A PUBLIC OR PRIVATE entity or person has completed SHALL, WITHIN 30 DAYS
18	OF COMPLETING activity that has disturbed or destroyed a monument or the accessories to a monument, the entity
19	or person shall engage a registered surveyor to REQUIRE THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES TO BE PERFORMED BY A
20	PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR, AS DEFINED IN 37-67-101, OR A QUALIFIED PERSON UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION
21	OF A PROFESSIONAL LAND SURVEYOR:
22	(a) restore or replace the monument or the accessories to the monument, using the references
23	established in subsection (1)(b); and
24	(b) file a new corner record as required in 70-22-104 AND 70-22-105.

26	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
27	integral part of Title 70, chapter 22, part 1, and the provisions of Title 70, chapter 22, part 1, apply to [section 1].
