7	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9	Section 1. Section 27-1-220, MCA, is amended to read:
10	"27-1-220. Punitive damages when allowed limitation. (1) Except as otherwise expressly
11	provided by statute and subject to subsection (3), a judge or jury may award, in addition to compensatory
12	damages, punitive damages for the sake of example and for the purpose of punishing a defendant.
13	(2) (a) Unless otherwise expressly provided by statute, punitive damages may not be recovered in any
14	action arising from:
15	(i) contract; or
16	(ii) breach of contract.
17	(b) Subsection (2)(a) does not prohibit recovery of punitive damages in a products liability action or an
18	action arising under 33-18-201.
19	(3) An award for punitive damages may not exceed \$10 million OR 3% OF A DEFENDANT'S NET WORTH,
20	WHICHEVER IS LESS. THIS SUBSECTION DOES NOT LIMIT PUNITIVE DAMAGES THAT MAY BE AWARDED IN CLASS ACTION
21	LAWSUITS. If a defendant's net worth is \$33 million or less, an award for punitive damages may not exceed 3%
22	of the defendant's net worth."
