10	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12	Section 1. Section 7-1-112, MCA, is amended to read:
13	"7-1-112. Powers requiring delegation. A local government with self-government powers is prohibited
14	the exercise of the following powers unless the power is specifically delegated by law:
15	(1) the power to authorize a tax on income or the sale of goods or services, except that, subject to
16	15-10-420, this section may not be construed to limit the authority of a local government to levy any other tax
17	or establish the rate of any other tax;
18	(2) the power to regulate private activity beyond its geographic limits;
19	(3) the power to impose a duty on another unit of local government, except that nothing in this limitation
20	affects the right of a self-government unit to enter into and enforce an agreement on interlocal cooperation;
21	(4) the power to exercise any judicial function, except as an incident to the exercise of an independent
22	self-government administrative power;
23	(5) the power to regulate any form of gambling, lotteries, or gift enterprises:
24	(6) the power to impose or exact a monetary fee or property dedication as a condition of the approval
25	of any subdivision, site plan, annexation, building permit, or other land use that is subject to approval by the local
26	government."
