8	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10	NEW SECTION. Section 1. Access to designated public areas for gathering ballot signatures.
11	(1) An owner of a retail shopping center or mall that maintains a policy of allowing charitable, civic, or political
12	groups to use designated public areas on the premises of the owner's retail shopping center or mall shall allow
13	a signature gatherer reasonable access to designated public areas for the purpose of collecting signatures for
14	a petition of an initiative or referendum pursuant to this chapter.
15	(2) An owner of a retail shopping center or mall referred to under subsection (1):
16	(a) may set reasonable restrictions on the time, manner, and place for a signature gatherer to collect
17	signatures; and
18	(b) may not discriminate among signature gatherers of different political groups.

20	NEW SECTION. Section 2. Codification instruction. [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an
21	integral part of Title 13, chapter 27, part 1, and the provisions of Title 13, chapter 27, part 1, apply to [section 1].

23	NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
