13	"10-3-1217. Liability of persons and response team members rendering assistance. (1) The state
14	or a political subdivision of the state, the commission, the local emergency response authority, and the state
15	hazardous material incident response team or, except for willful misconduct, gross negligence, or bad faith, an
16	employee, representative, or agent of the state or a political subdivision of the state, the commission, the local
17	emergency response authority, and the state hazardous material incident response team is The EXCEPT FOR
18	WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OR GROSS NEGLIGENCE, THE THE following are not liable under this part for injuries, costs,
19	damages, expenses, or other liabilities resulting from the release or threatened release or remedial action
20	resulting from the release or threatened release of a hazardous material:
21	(a) the state or a political subdivision of the state;
22	(b) the commission;
23	(c) the local emergency response authority;
24	(d) the state hazardous material incident response team;
25	(e) a private EMERGENCY response team contracted DISPATCHED by the state, a political subdivision of
26	the state, or a local or tribal emergency response authority FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACTIVITIES; and
27	(f) except for willful misconduct, gross negligence, or bad faith, an employee, representative, or agent
28	of any of the entities listed in subsections (1)(a) through (1)(e), EXCEPT FOR WILLFUL MISCONDUCT OR GROSS

30	(2) The immunity includes but is not limited to indemnification, contribution, or third-party claims for

(3) A person becomes a member of the state hazardous material incident response team when the
