4	A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF
5	MONTANA SUPPORTING A HEALTHY SCHOOL ENVIRONMENT BY URGING SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO
6	OFFER NUTRITIOUS FOOD AND BEVERAGE CHOICES AND PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR PHYSICAL
7	ACTIVITY WHENEVER POSSIBLE.

9	WHEREAS, obesity in children is a national epidemic and can lead to chronic diseases, such as hear
10	disease, stroke, diabetes, and cancer; and
11	WHEREAS, the majority of children's diets are not meeting national nutrition recommendations; and
12	WHEREAS, children make food and beverage choices in a variety of school settings, including school
13	breakfast and lunch, the use of vending machines, the purchase of concessions, and after school programs; and
14	WHEREAS, Medicaid and health care costs are a growing issue of concern in Montana and are
15	significantly impacted by obesity; and
16	WHEREAS, good nutrition and adequate physical activity help children grow, develop, and do well in
17	school; and
18	WHEREAS, healthy bodies and minds are major contributors to readiness to learn, to improved school
19	attendance, and to improved performance in sports and other extracurricular activities; and
20	WHEREAS, school-based nutrition education and physical activity support healthy eating habits and ar
21	active lifestyle; and
22	WHEREAS, wholesome foods produced in Montana should be available and actively promoted in a
23	healthy school environment; and
24	WHEREAS, the Legislature needs to identify long-term strategies to reduce the need for public
25	assistance programs, such as Medicaid, and to lower health care costs related to chronic diseases and poo
26	dental health.

28	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
29	THE STATE OF MONTANA:
30	That the Montana Legislature support implementation of school policies that ensure a healthy

1 environment in our schools and that encourage children to eat well and be physically active throughout the 2 school day.

- 3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Montana Legislature urge local school districts to offer nutritious
- 4 food and beverage choices and provide opportunities for physical activity whenever possible.
- 5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Secretary of State send a copy of this resolution to the
- 6 Superintendent of Public Instruction for distribution to every school district in Montana.
