Gallons of Ethanol-Blended Fuel Used by State

In late 2004, the U.S. Department of Transportation released fuel usage statistics for the previous year. According to the Office of Highway Policy, these are the most recent statistics available for the usage of ethanol-blended fuel across the country.

Ethanol blends are defined as three types of "gasohol": 10% ethanol, 7.7% ethanol (which contains at least 7.7% ethanol but less than 10%), 5.7% ethanol (which contains at least 5.7% ethanol but less than 7.7%). The table treats all levels the same.

Approximately 60% of ethanol-blended fuel is sold as E10, with the remaining 40% is sold as either 7.7% or 5.7% blends. California is the most notable state selling fuel in the 5.7% ethanol blend. These figures are for 2003, prior to the January 1, 2004 deadline for California, New York, and Connecticut to begin selling ethanol-blended fuel.
