1. Page B-5, line 14.

Strike: "8,550,526 8,666,927" [state special revenue
FY06 and FY07]

Insert: "5,300,526 5,416,927"

2. Page B-5.

Following: line 22

Insert: "e. Mental Health Services Plan (Restricted/Biennial)
6,500,000" [state special revenue FY06]

3. Page B-13, following line 6.

Insert: "In fiscal year 2006, funds in item Mental Health Services
Plan may be used only for the mental health services program
authorized in 53-21-702(2) and for state medicaid matching
funds to implement Senate Bill No. 110."

Explanation: This amendment line items and restricts the use of
the state special revenue from tobacco taxes (I-149) appropriated
for the Mental Health Services Plan (MHSP). The restriction would
prohibit the funds from being used for any reason other than the
MHSP program or state match to implement Medicaid redesign
proposals, including the HIFA (Health Insurance Flexibility and
Accountability) waiver.

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
