**"37-69-304. Qualifications of applicants for journeyman plumber's license -- restriction on authority -- fees -- third-party services.** (1) ~~The~~ An applicant must meet the following requirements must be met by applicants for a journeyman plumber's license:

(a) a specific record of 5 years' experience legally obtained in the field of plumbing of a ~~character satisfactory to the board~~. This experience requirement may be fulfilled by working 5 years in a major phase of the plumbing business, verified by time or pay records, or by completing an apprenticeship program meeting the standards set by the department of labor and industry or the United States department of labor, bureau of apprenticeship, ~~or credit~~. Credit towards this experience requirement may be given for time spent attending an accredited trade or other school specializing in training of value in the field of plumbing and approved by the board.

(b) satisfactory completion of an examination conducted by the department, subject to 37-1-101(4), testing the applicant's knowledge of techniques and methods employed in the field of plumbing and establishing by practical demonstration competence in the special skills required in the field of plumbing.

(2) A licensed journeyman plumber may perform work only in the employment of a licensed master plumber unless otherwise permitted by rule of the board.

(3) The board shall determine by rule the fees to be charged an applicant for each examination or reexamination. The fees must be commensurate with costs.

(4) The department may use a third party to provide examination and grading services."
