1. Title, line 9.

Following: "CONTRACT;"

Insert: "REQUIRING THE COLLECTED INFORMATION TO BE FORWARDED TO THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR;"

2. Page 1, line 22.

Following: "services"

Insert: ", when the contract is not an on-call or fixed price individual services contract, when the primary purpose of the contract is to provide services by individuals, and when the services are currently an existing function provided by state employees,"

3. Page 1, line 23 through line 25.

Strike: "the number" on line 23 through "contract" on line 25

Insert: ":

(a) the anticipated number of individuals to be employed as supervisors, managers, direct service personnel, and support service personnel;

(b) the anticipated number of hours to be worked by individuals described in subsection (4)(a); and

(c) the wages, salaries, and benefits to be paid to the individuals described in subsection (4)(a)"

4. Page 1, following line 25.

Insert: "(5)(a) Each agency subject to the provisions of subsection (4) shall provide the information compiled pursuant to subsection (4) to the legislative auditor on a form provided by the legislative auditor.

(b) An agency that is party to an on-call or fixed price contract for individual services shall provide the information required in subsection (4) to the legislative auditor on a quarterly basis.

(c) An agency shall update the information required in subsection (4) if a significant contract modification of a contract subject to the provisions of subsection (4) is requested by a party to the contract and shall forward that updated

information to the legislative auditor on a form provided by the auditor."
