Following: "PONDS;"

Insert: "PROVIDING THAT IF, FOLLOWING SITE INSPECTION, IT IS DETERMINED THAT THERE IS NO POSSIBILITY OF FISH ESCAPING FROM A POND INTO ADJACENT STREAMS OR LAKES A NEW FISH POND LICENSE OR LICENSE RENEWAL IS NOT REQUIRED UNLESS THE PERSON WHO OWNS OR LAWFULLY CONTROLS THE POND DESIRES TO SELL FISH, EGGS, OR FRY;"

2. Page 1, line 27.

Following: "section."

Insert: "If, following site inspection, the department determines that there is no possibility of fish escaping from the pond into adjacent streams or lakes, then a license renewal is not required unless the person who owns or lawfully controls the pond desires to sell fish, eggs, or fry."

3. Page 2, line 5.

Following: "department."

Insert: "If, following site inspection, the department determines that there is no possibility of fish escaping from the pond into adjacent streams or lakes, then a license is not required unless the person who owns or lawfully controls the pond desires to sell fish, eggs, or fry."
