DP 67: Weed Management Biotech 1.5 FTE (Agriculture Experiment Station) Match Language

From Page E-148 of the Legislative Budget Analysis 2007 Biennium

~~“The general fund money in item DP 67 [Appropriation Distribution (09) (Governor’s Initiative)] is appropriated with the condition that the item is “Item 7e includes \$159,966 in general fund money for integrated weed management and biotechnology (1.5 FTE), which must be matched with \$159,967 from \$79,983 in nonstate funds identified by the board or regents. Matched funds for these items may include federal funding revenue, private funding revenue, and other nonstate university funds. The funding match may include in-kind revenue only if that revenue is equipment, cost reductions offered for purchased equipment, or space to house equipment. The office of the commissioner of higher education must shall certify to the office of budget and program planning that the matching sources have been identified and committed for the purpose of supporting an integrated weed management and biotechnology program” that an allowable funding match has been committed from an eligible revenue source, as evidenced by a commitment letter from that funding source.”~~

Adopted Language: "Item 7e includes \$159,966 in general fund money for integrated weed management and biotechnology (1.5 FTE), which must be matched with \$79,983 in nonstate funds identified by the board or regents. Matched funds for these items may include federal funding revenue, private funding revenue, and other nonstate university funds. Matched funds for these items may include federal funding revenue, private funding revenue, and other nonstate university funds. The funding match may include in-kind revenue only if that revenue is equipment, cost reductions offered for purchased equipment, or space to house equipment. The office of the commissioner of higher education must shall certify to the office of budget and program planning that the matching sources have been identified and committed for the purpose of supporting a cropping specialist (livestock specialist) program”~~ that an allowable funding match has been committed from an eligible revenue source, as evidenced by a commitment letter from that funding source.”

NP 88 Wildland/Urban Interface

Matched funds for these items may include federal funding revenue, private funding revenue, and other nonstate university funds. The funding match may include in-kind revenue only if that revenue is equipment, cost reductions offered for purchased equipment, or space to house equipment. The office of the commissioner of higher education shall certify to the office of budget and program planning that an allowable funding match has been committed from an eligible revenue source, as evidenced by a commitment letter from that funding source.”
