Dear Eve,

Here we are in a historic time in Montana. I realize the enormous task facing the legislation right now - the future generations of children will be impacted by your decision and I understand how heavily that must weigh upon you. *As I thought about the decision before you, I remembered how my mother and sister (social worker and counselor) have advised me so wisely - "Err always on the side of children." So I would offer those words to you today - make your decision with children in mind. They can make our state more humane, safer, more creative, more compassionate, and more wonderful.

I believe that most often people fail to mark the historic time in which they live. This is truly one of those times for Montana. The acknowledgement of the indigenous people of this state and their sacrifice and contribution that helped to shape the landscape of our world today had long been ignored or dismissed. What courage it took for the constitutional delegates to give voice to that truth. Now, once again we are faced with how we will honor and live up to that promise. The opportunity to do this well is before us. It will not come to us again as it is here now. I humbly ask you to be generous in fulfilling a constitutional guarantee long overdue. It will make a difference in the lives of all of our children.

Thank you for giving thought and heartfelt consideration to making a good decision. Your efforts will not go unnoticed.

Never underestimate what a single act of integrity will accomplish!
